Certainly one of the longest running outdoor sunrise services in the nation. This years attendance was estimated to be around 3000 people. In order for all those people to get safely to the top before dawn, the Scouts of Mt. Rubidoux district get to work.

On Saturday all the district units from Cub Scouts to Crews and even some Girl Scouts come out and do trail work to make the passage safe for the early morning trek. The trails are cleared, ruts filled in and all the trash is removed.

Then very early on Sunday morning the Webelos, Troops, Teams, and Crews returned to light the trails, as the Scouts have done for almost 100 years, for those making their way to the top of the mountain.

Altogether over 500 Scouts and Scouters participated and gave over 2000 hours of cheerful service for the weekend. All this effort is coordinated by the Wanakik Chapter of the Order of the Arrow.
